Pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Order M.R. 30370, all civil and criminal jury trials for St. Clair, Monroe, Randolph, Perry and Washington Counties are vacated and continued for the next sixty (60) days and until order of the Chief Judge. In the case of criminal proceedings, any delay resulting from this emergency continuance order shall not be attributable to either the State or the defendant for purposes of Section 103-5 of the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 (725 ILCS 5/103-5 (West 2018)). Furthermore, no jury trials shall be scheduled to begin during this period of time.
