COVID-19 ORDER NUMBER 3

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, leading to health and safety concerns resulting in substantial operational impediments, and the proclamations of states of emergency by federal, state, and local officials, the Chief Justice of the California Supreme Court has determined that the conditions described in section 68115(a) of the Government Code have been met with regard to the Superior Court of San Mateo County as of March 16, 2020. At the request of this Court, an Order issued by the Chief Justice on that date authorized San Mateo County Superior Court to implement certain relief authorized by section 68115(a). Upon a renewed request made by the Presiding Judge of the San Mateo County Superior Court, the Chief Justice on April 2, 2020 determined that the conditions described in section 68115(a) continue to exist. As a result, the Chief Justice authorized the San Mateo County Superior Court to do the following, which this Court hereby orders, effective immediately:

- 1 • April 1, 2020 to May 14, 2020 inclusive, are deemed holidays for purposes of
2 computing the time for filing papers with the court under Code of Civil Procedure
3 sections 12 and 12a (Gov. Code § 68115(a)(4)); and
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5 • April 1, 2020 to May 14, 2020, inclusive, are deemed holidays for purposes of
6 computing time under Welfare and Institutions Code sections 313, 315, 334, 631,
7 632, 637, and 657 (Gov. Code § 68115(a)(5)).
