FIFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Pursuant to the authority vested in me, in accordance with the recent operational protocols issued by the Chief Administrative Judge for the trial courts of the Unified Court System and in furtherance of Administrative Order No. 5A02020-50 signed on March 28, 2020, establishing "virtual courtrooms" throughout the Fifth District in response to the unprecedented public health crisis caused by the COVID-19 virus, it is hereby

ORDERED, that, until further order, no one appearing with a detained defendant seeking a "walk-in" arraignment shall be allowed to enter the buildings where the Centralized Arraignment Parts are located in Oneida, Onondaga and Oswego Counties; and it is further

ORDERED, that the local Court Clerk and/or his/her designee located within the Central Court location in each County is hereby authorized to scan RAP Sheets (Record of Arrests and Prosecution) from the Integrated Justice Portal (E-Justice) for use in the "virtual courtrooms."
