

THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, causing health and safety concerns and findings by the California Department of Public Health that that gatherings in venues that do not allow for social distancing of six feet per person be cancelled, it has been determined that the conditions described in section 68115 of the Government Code are met with regard to the Superior Court of California, County of Nevada. Due to the pandemic, Governor Gavin Newsom has declared a statewide state of emergency. Upon the request of Presiding Judge Linda J. Sloven, it is ordered that the Superior Court of Nevada County is authorized to do the following:

- Extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than 30 days, applicable only to cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from March 16, 2020, to April 14, 2020, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)).
