

THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the proclamations of a states of emergency by Governor Gavin Newsom and President Donald Trump, it has been determined that the conditions described in section 68115 of the Government Code are met with regard to the Superior Court of Santa Clara County. Upon the request of Presiding Judge Deborah Ryan, it is ordered that the Superior Court of Santa Clara County is authorized to do the following:

- Extend by not more than 21 days the duration of any temporary restraining order that would otherwise expire from March 16, 2020 through April 5, 2020 because the emergency condition prevented the court from conducting proceedings to determine whether a permanent order should be entered. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(7).)
